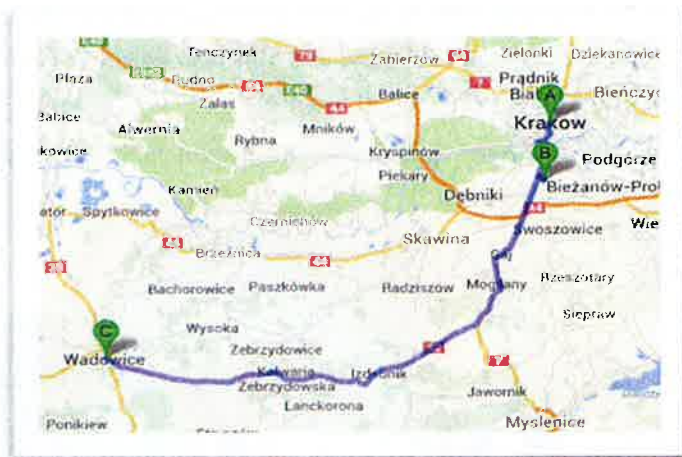

Sample Trip Itinerary

July 20: Departure from USA to Krakow. Dinner and Breakfast will be served in-flight.

July 21: Arrival in Krakow. Check into hotel. Then it's off to Auschwitz where you will visit the impressive Holocaust Memorial. (Included in trip but may not be visited based on group leader approval) Day tour of Krakow with your guide. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 22: Today we will go to Zakopane. After a tour of the city, enjoy free time to stroll through the town's most popular street: Krupówki, lined with stores, restaurants, carnival rides, and performers. Perhaps you will buy an oscypek or a ciupaga (both unique to Zakopane) to take home with you. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight.

July 23: After breakfast, take a tour of Wawel Royal Castle and the Cathedral. Then descend into the underground chambers of the Wieliczka Salt Mines for an unparalleled tour of the medieval galleries and halls carved out of rocks and salt deposits. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

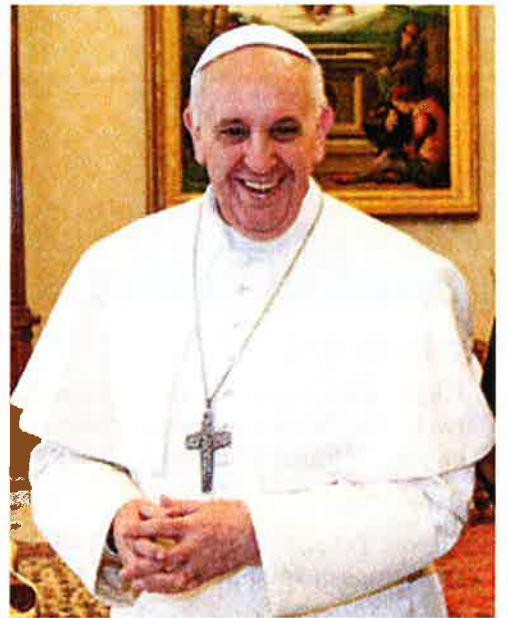
July 24: After breakfast, depart for Lagiewniki which is the capital of the Divine Mercy where Christ Himself wished to pass on to our generation, through the mediation of St. Faustina. The Sanctuary houses grace-working images of Merciful Jesus and the relics of St. Faustina. Visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy, St. Faustina's convent chapel, and her tomb. See the displayed relic of St. John Paul II where his robe contains the blood stain from when he was shot in 1981. Depart for Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyła. Visit the church he was to have attended and was baptized as a child. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 25: After breakfast, take a bus ride north to Czestochowa. Visit Our Lady of Czestochowa, Poland's greatest pilgrimage shrine, where there will be mass. Then visit Jasna Gora Monastery. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 26: After breakfast, WYD begins with the official welcome of pilgrims followed by the opening ceremonies in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 27: Morning catechesis. This afternoon and evening visit the Way of the Cross, Monastery, and Shrine in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 28: Morning catechesis, afternoon and evening WYD



events. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 29: Morning catechesis, afternoon and evening WYD events and Stations of the Cross. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 30: Pilgrimage Walk. Evening Prayer Vigil with our Holy Father. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

July 31: Morning Mass with our Holy Father. Pilgrimage Walk back to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

August 1: Departure for USA from Krakow.
